Skill lessons

5 lessons on the mathematics the book carries. Each lesson has printable workbook pages and a separate teacher key.

1. Which Hand Tells the Hour

Concept · Telling time to the hour from the positions of the two hands

2. Five for Every Number

Fluency · Skip counting by fives to sixty around the clock face

3. How Many Hours Until Parents Night

Application · Finding how many whole hours remain before a later hour

4. Half Past Ten and Forty-Five Past Two

Representation · Reading and writing times to five minutes past the hour

5. Two Eight O'Clocks in One Day

Reasoning · Ordering the hours of one day and sorting them into morning and evening

Math through the reading

The mathematics is reached through a sentence the book prints: change one word in the reading and the numbers change with it. These carry their own standards, matched against these lessons rather than inherited from the skill ones.

6. Count By, Count To

Integrated · Students run the same clock face twice, once counting by fives and once counting to five, and say which word the class was given and what it made the numbers do.

7. The Hour the Story Skips

Integrated · Students find the two sentences that fix the moment and the deadline, then count the hours the story never counts for them.

8. Six Hours and Four Hours

Integrated · Students build the story's two amounts of time left as two towers, find the difference, and say the relation both ways round about one arrangement.

Reading and language lessons

4 lessons on the reading and language the book carries - what a word means in its sentence, how a character is shown, how a text is built. No mathematics: these are matched against the English language arts curricula, which are a different and smaller set than the mathematics ones.
