Box of Shocks (EBook) - Grade 5 - Short lesson

TIME	OBJECTIVE
10 minutes	Arrange three collection events in their text-supported chronological order.

PRODUCT

A three-step timeline with one event per step.

Essential question: In what order does Oliver obtain the candy, the chewed spike, and the bridge : bolt?

Materials	Text to mark
• The book	• Passage 3 - Milburn House - Oliver saves the Halloween candy

- Prepared passages: Passage 3, Passage 4, Passage 5
- Student response materials

Lesson sequence

1 Set the sequence - 2 min

- Passage 4 - Spike McChomp - Oliver keeps the chewed metal spike
- Passage 5 - Pegasus Valley Bridge - Oliver carries away the bridge bolt

In what order does Oliver obtain the candy, the chewed spike, and the bridge bolt?

Prepared text:	Passage 3, Passage 4, Passage 5 2 Work the evidence - 5 min Reread Passages 3-5. Have students identify the souvenir in each episode and place the three events in source order, using first, next, and later.
Prepared text:	Passage 3, Passage 4, Passage 5 3 Make the student product - 3 min Have students build a three-step timeline with one event per step and use sequence words to show the order.
Prepared text:	Passage 3, Passage 4, Passage 5

Teacher key

Oliver first adds the Milburn House candy, next adds Spike : Oliver first adds the Milburn House candy, next adds Spike McChomp's chewed spike, and later carries away the bridge bolt.

Support & extension

Above: Add one sentence explaining how the increasing physical danger links the three episodes structurally.

Below: Provide three object cards for the student to number and pair with Milburn House, Spike McChomp, and Pegasus Valley Bridge.

Assessment

- • Places the candy first, the spike second, and the bolt third • Connects each object to the correct adventure • Uses sequence words Essential question: In what order does Oliver obtain the candy, the chewed spike, and the bridge bolt?
