Goodnight, Goodnight, Construction Site - Grade K - Short lesson

TIME

OBJECTIVE

PRODUCT

15 minutes Read the whole book and explain what happens to each truck, and Three boxes for a truck's turn, how the book ends. and the last page Essential question: Five trucks, one bedtime each. What happens the same way every time?

Materials	Text to mark
• The book	• Passage 6 - goodnight, crane truck
• One case sheet each	• Passage 11 - dump truck's loads

- Prepared passages: Passage 6, Passage 11, Passage 13

Lesson sequence

1 Before reading - 3 min

- Passage 13 - the dump truck settles

Focus:	A bedtime routine, for machines
Teacher direction:	Ask the class what they do to get ready for bed, in order. Keep the list up: the book is going to do the same thing five times.
Prepared text:	Passage 6 2 Teacher model - 5 min
Teacher model:	I read the end of the crane truck's turn and the line after it. Notice the line after it is not part of the story - it is somebody speaking softly to the truck, the way you would to a child who is nearly asleep. It is printed in slanted letters, and it comes back every time.
Prepared text:	Passage 6 3 How each truck's turn goes - 7 min
Focus:	Work, then one last job, then bed
Teacher direction:	Using Passages 6, 11 and 13, write what happens to each truck.

Expected answer:	Each truck works all day, does one last job, then puts itself to bed with its own parts. The dump truck lowers its bed and locks its gate, rests its wheels, dims its lights, shuts its doors, and its engine slows into snores. Then the soft line comes, saying goodnight to that truck by name. Five trucks, five turns, and the same soft line after every one.
Student product:	Three boxes: the work, the last job, going to bed
Prepared text:	Passage 6, Passage 11, Passage 13

Support & extension

Above: The book says goodnight to each truck by name. Explain who you think is saying it.

Below: Fill the three boxes for one truck, then the last page.

Assessment

- Names three of the trucks
- Says what each truck does before bed
- Gives the soft line that comes after each turn
- Says what the trucks use to put themselves to bed
- Describes the last page
